

# LOCAL RULES BRITISH ARMY GOLF CLUB SENNELAGER

## OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18.2)

Out of bounds is marked by white stakes. The fences on the left side of the holes 2, 3, 14, 17 and 18 define the exclusion limit.

## GROUND UNDER REPAIR; UNUSUAL PLAYING CONDITIONS (RULE 16.1)

Ground under repair is marked by blue stakes, blue markers, white paint markings on the ground, green stakes with white rope or markings with "GUR" (Ground Under Repair). If a player's ball is located in this area or obstructs the stance or line of the player's intended swing, the player MAY take relief under Rule 16.1.

## RELIEF FROM ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS, DANGEROUS ANIMAL CONDITION, EMBEDDED BALL

Facilitation under regulation 16.1 of holes, raised ground or walkways by digging animals or birds shall not be granted if only the standing position is obstructed.

## ANIMAL HOOF PRINTS

Damage in the terrain which was clearly caused by animal hooves shall be granted relief in accordance with 16.1.

## NO-PLAY ZONES (RULE 16.1F)

You are not allowed to play from the following areas:

- Young trees (marked by poles or fences)
- Rhododendron Bushes
- Anthill

If the ball is located in any of the listed no-play zones, the position of the stance or the area of the player's intended swing is obstructed, facilitation under Rule 16.1b (impunity) MUST be applied or the ball declared unplayable under Rule 19 (subject to penalty).

## PROVISIONAL BALL FOR BALL IN THE PENALTY AREA AT HOLE 15 (LOCAL RULE 8B3)

If a ball in the penalty area has come to rest on hole 15, a provisional ball may be played in accordance with Rule 17.1d(1) (relief from strike and loss of distance) or Rule 17.1d(2) (relief on the line back). If the original ball is found outside the penalty area, play must continue with that ball.

If the original ball is in the penalty area, the player may play the original ball as it is, or continue play with the provisional ball, but may not proceed with the original ball in accordance with Rule 17.1.

If the original ball is not found within the search time of 3 minutes, but it is known or almost certain that the ball is in the penalty area, the provisional ball becomes the ball in play.

## PENALTY FOR VIOLATING A LOCAL RULE:

Strokeplay = basic penalty (2 penalty shots); Matchplay = loss of hole

## OTHER

Special local rules see notice board

Distance poles and distance markings to front of Green:

- 200 m = 3 stripes
- 150 m = 2 stripes
- 100 m = 1 stripe
